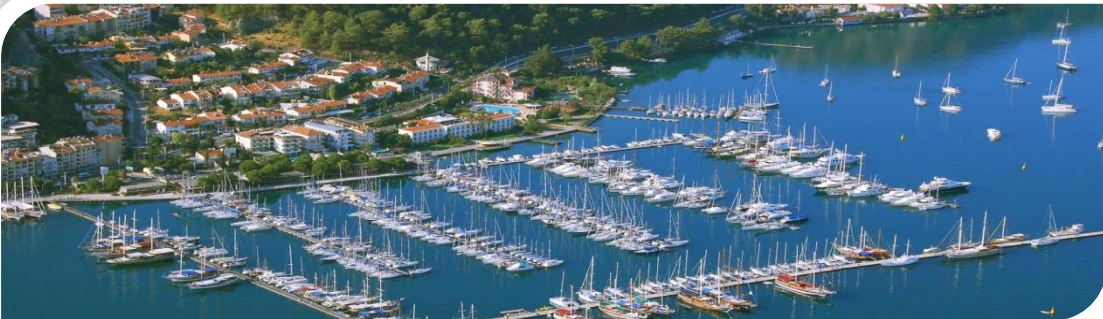

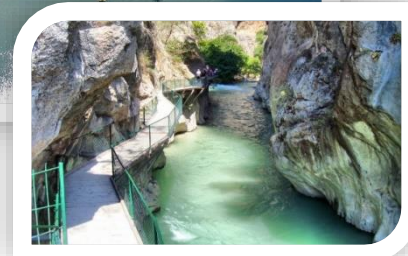






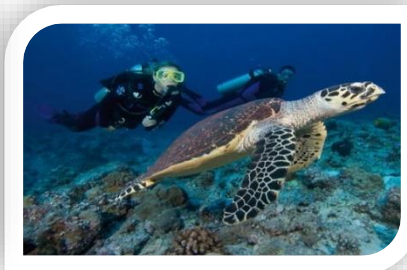

There are many brief synopses of Fethiye, that explain more about this pretty harbor town, a seaside location which gives a new meaning to the color “turquoise” possessing the most beautiful beaches and islands of the Aegean Sea and a holiday paradise with stunning nature and impressive historical sites.

It is assumed that Fethiye, often referred to as “the untouched virgin of the Land of Lights,” was established in the 5<sup>th</sup> century B.C. The city, which was formerly known as Telmessos, used to be one of the most important residential areas of Lycia. Furthermore, Fethiye was also a center of prophecy and one of the most cultivated cities of the Roman and Byzantine periods.



The city was named as Meğri after its subordination to the Ottomans in 1424 and was renamed as Fethiye in memory of martyr pilot Fethi Bey in 1934. Fethiye, is a district of Muğla Province with a typical Mediterranean climate. The weather is hot and dry in the summer and

mild and rainy in the winter. Moreover, the town offers many vacation and past time options including magnificent holiday resorts that name it as a popular holiday destination while she preserves her roots and traditions, a variety of cultural heritages with relics of Fethiye’s ancient past spread in and around the town; Roman amphitheatre on the harbour, a medieval castle on the hill above the town and Lycian Rock Tombs are the ones among the many to be spotted. Fethiye is also known internationally with a series of sport facilities such as paragliding and scuba diving. The ancient city is almost like an open-air museum with a wide range of historical monuments and archaeological sites and fascinates visitors with its natural beauties.

## Dalyan



Dalyan is a small, and popular village located between Fethiye and Marmaris. It is most well known by Iztuzu Beach, Caretta Caretta Turtles, mud bath, nature, and historical monuments. It attracts many tourists every year. Blue crab, many different species of birds, fishes, turtles are all spottable in their natural life. The ancient city Kaunos was built 400 BC, and is a walking distance from the center of the village. High on the cliffs above Kaunos you can see the unique and magnificently carved Lycian rock tombs. This funeral culture unique in history, was done only by the Lycians.



Caretta caretta turtles are protected and monitored by Environmental Protection Agency for Special regions. It is a perfect day out for scenery, mud bath experience made naturally with sulphur spring water. Most people believe this experience as anti-aging lifetime experience with the bonus of nature stunning views and historical heritage in the surrounds.

## Bodrum / Halicarnassus

Bodrum is a district and a port city in Muğla Province, in the southwestern Aegean Region of Turkey. It is located on the southern coast of Bodrum Peninsula, at a point that checks the entry into the Gulf of Gökova, and is also the center of the eponymous district. The city was called Halicarnassus of Caria in ancient times and was famous for housing the Mausoleum of Mausolus, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Bodrum Castle, built by the Knights Hospitaller in the 15th century, overlooks the harbour and the marina. The castle grounds include a Museum of Underwater Archaeology and hosts several cultural festivals throughout the year.

Halicarnassus was an ancient Greek city at the site of modern Bodrum. It was located in southwest Caria on a picturesque, advantageous site on the Gulf of Gökova. The city was famous for the tomb of Mausolus, the origin of the word mausoleum, built between 353 BC and 350 BC, and one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. It was part of the Persian Empire until captured by Alexander the Great at the siege of Halicarnassus in 334 BC.



## Blue Lagoon / Dead Sea

Also called Blue Lagoon, Dead Sea is a resort village in Fethiye. It's one of the most popularly photographed beach with amazingly Blue Ocean and beach and most of the time lands on the top 5 beaches in the world. Blue Lagoon is along the 500kms Lycian Way walk.



## Butterfly Valley

A wide-strip sand beach at a bay on the Turkish Riviera protrudes from the valley. In the form of a narrow canyon stretching over around 3–4 km (1.9–2.5 mi), the valley's steep walls are 350–400 m (1,150–1,310 ft) high. A trail in the valley leads to two small waterfalls dropping from 60 m (200 ft) all the year around. In the middle of the valley, a creek runs, carrying water from a spring in nearby Faralya village to the sea.

The valley, rich in flora and fauna, takes its name from the large number of butterfly species found here. Scientists recorded some 147 flora species belonging to 54 families and 105 butterfly species from 15 families native to the valley. The butterfly species include the Jersey tiger.

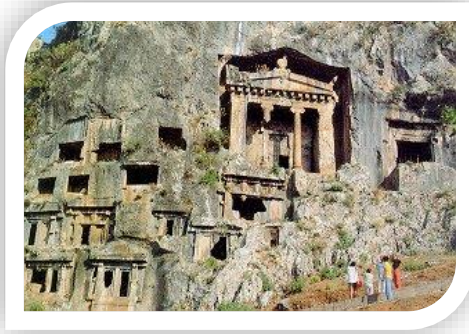

## Telmessos Ancient City

Telmessos was a flourishing city in the west of Lycia, on the Gulf of Fethiye. It was famed for its school of diviners, consulted among others by the Lydian king Croesus, prior to declaring war against Cyrus, and by Alexander the Great, when he came to the town after the siege of Halicarnassus.

As mentioned in the ancient sources, there was a big theatre in Telmessos. During the drill excavations carried on by the Directorate General of Fethiye Museum in 1993, seats of the theatre were found 3-4 meters under the soil layers formed because of erosion. After the excavations concluded in 1995, all the extant remains of the theatre were re-surfaced. Built in the early Roman Period and repaired in 2000 AD, it is known that the theatre with a capacity of 5000 seats was used as an arena. At present, the theatre has a seating capacity of 1500 people.



## Kayaköy

Kayaköy was a settlement region of Rums (Greeks of Turkish Nationality) in the 14th century. It was founded on the lands of ancient city Karmillassos which had been demolished almost completely excluding a few home-type tombs due to earthquakes. Its ancient name is Levissi. Becoming united with the people of surrounding five Turkish villages and teaching humanity on the concepts of friendship, brotherhood and peace throughout its history, Kayaköy is one of the most important regions. According to the agreement of population exchange signed between Turkish and Greek governments in 1922, Rums living in Kayaköy were exchanged by Turks living in the western Thrace.

## Fethiye Museum

The Museum has two exhibition halls namely, Archaeology Hall and Ethnography Hall. In the Archaeology Hall, there are ceramic works and statues. Among these, there is a Young Girl's Statue with a Dove and a trilingual stele, which has played an important role to analyse the Lycian language. Hand woven works special to the region, silver jewellery and dastar (head scarf) loom are exhibited in the Ethnography Hall. In the open exhibition, big stone works of art, tombs and Izraza Monument can be seen. The Museum is open everyday except Monday from 09.00 to 18.00.

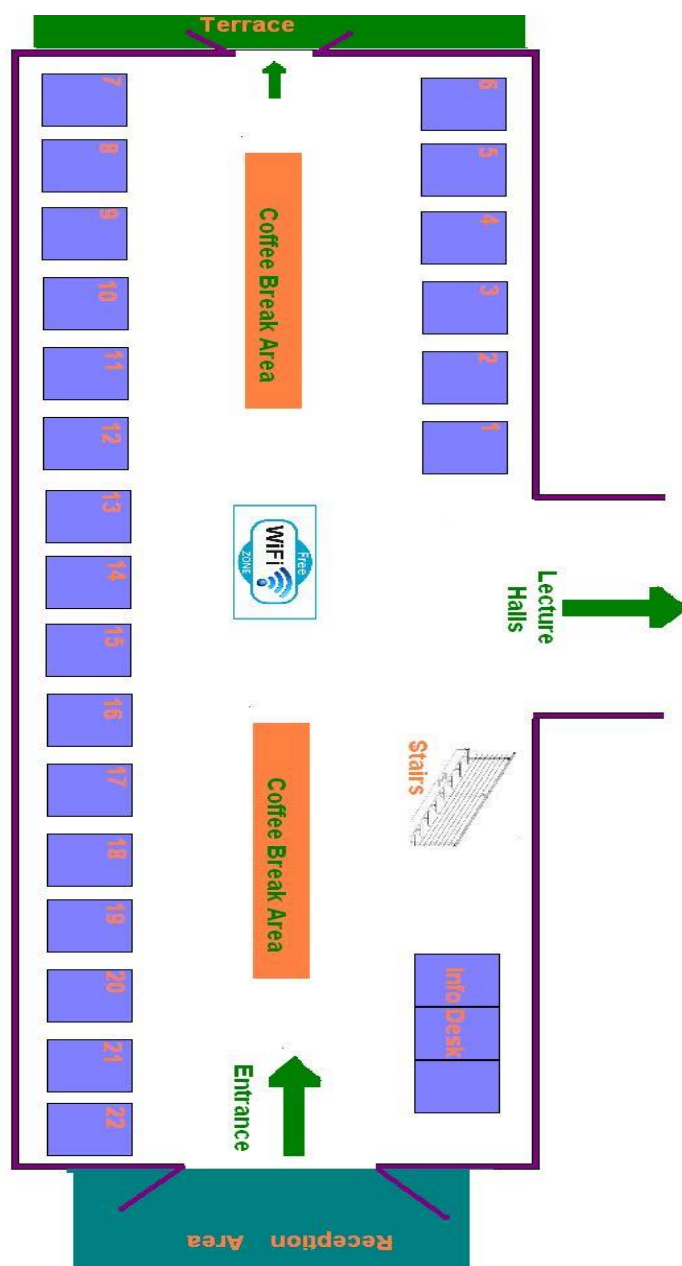
